

Background

While Kerala is trying to catch up with other states in India in information technology and biotechnology, Kerala should explore the possibility to leapfrog to the next generation technologies including, nanotechnology, nanobio convergence technologies, nanomedicine, electronic and optical devices, biomedical, alternative energy generation and storage, medical devices and products, high end IT and other next generation products from chemical and physical sciences, IT and pharmaceutical industry. Ultimately, in ten years, Kerala should become the number one state in India in new technologies. Kerala can do it because it has the knowledge power. Since Kerala can't compete in low tech and mass manufacturing areas because of higher cost compared to other states, the only option is to go toward high value added products to compete in the international market.
